

TERMINATION OF ORDER

The Judges of the Ross County, Ohio Court of Common Pleas, General & Domestic Division, and Juvenile & Probate Division, having reviewed current CDC and Ohio Department of Health guidelines, hereby rescind the **Temporary Order** filed March 18, 2020, effective June 2, 2021. Further, effective June 2, 2021, fully vaccinated individuals¹ will not be required to wear a mask when present on the courthouse premises.

¹ Individuals are considered fully vaccinated for Covid-19 ≥ 2 weeks after they have received the second dose in a 2-dose series (Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna), or ≥ 2 weeks after they have received a single-dose vaccine (Johnson & Johnson/Janssen).
